Spring has officially started and that means that warmer days are coming our way. The warm weather always brings a change in students dress for school. The way a person dresses says a lot about where they are going and the activity that they are going to do. If you are going for a job interview or to church, dressing up is very appropriate and if you are going to the park, shorts and tee shirt are good choices. When we think about school, it's a place where we want children to be comfortable and dress as if it were their place of work. We would like to ask you to help us monitor the selection of clothes worn to school by your children. Please use the following guidelines to determine what your children should or should not wear to school.

- Children can wear shorts to school, but they must be long enough to come to mid-thigh.
- Halter tops, spaghetti straps are not allowed.
- Students who wear T-shirts with inappropriate messages that distract from learning will be asked to call home for a change of clothes.
- Open toe or flip-flop shoes can be a problem on the playground as well as in physical education classes. Please encourage children to wear shoes that they can play in. Convertible roller shoes (tennis shoes with wheels that go up for walking, or down for skating) are not allowed at school.
- Children (either boys or girls) are not permitted to wear caps or hats in the building.

As you know the weather in Colorado can change on a dime. We strongly recommend that you have your child keep a jacket in their backpack for those cool days.

Preschool Early Enrollment for the 2010-11 School Year

The deadline for submitting early enrollment applications for the preschool tuition program for the 2010-11 school year is fast approaching! The applications must be received in the Early Childhood office at Eastridge Elementary (11777 E Wesley Ave, Aurora 80014-1869) by 4:00pm on March 26, 2010. Applications are available at the Early Childhood office, all CCSD preschools, elementary schools, and Admissions offices in addition to the District website.

Cherry Creek Schools will offer preschool classes that are 2-1/2 hours in length either 2 or 4 days per week at 27 different locations. Our program is for children who are 3 years old but not 5 years old as of October 1, 2010. We will also offer a Young 3's program at 5 different locations for children who turn 3 between Oct. 2 and Dec. 31, 2010.

Students Transferring within the Cherry Creek School District:


If students are planning to transfer to another school within the Cherry Creek School District, their meal account balance will be automatically transferred to the Cherry Creek School that they will attend next school year.
